For the past six years, Anat has been a member of the

Diva Jazz Orchestra (www.divajazz.com) and Five Play Jazz Quintet. Anat is featured on their latest CD, "TNT: A Tommy Newsom Tribute." While with Diva, Anat has had the opportunity to perform with guest artists such as Nancy Wilson, Dave Brubeck, Slide Hampton and Diane Schuur.

Ms. Cohen is an integral part of a group called Choro Ensemble (www.choroensemble.com), the only New York-based ensemble dedicated to the authentic instrumental choro tradition of Brazil. The group was a featured guest artist at the Apollo Theater with Wynton Marsalis and the Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra.

Anat's debut album as a bandleader entitled "Place & Time" is scheduled for release in early 2005. Her current duo project with pianist Alon Yavnai is receiving great acclaim and their debut CD, "Duo" is scheduled for release in Spring 2005. Anat also appears together with her two brothers, Yuval Cohen and Avishai Cohen, on BMG's CD - "Summa Cum Jazz". The 3 Cohens debut CD, "One" was released in June 2004.
